THE TROPARION OF THE RESURRECTION in Tone 5

Through thee the divine likeness was securely preserved, O Mother Euphrosyne; for thou didst carry the Cross and followed Christ. By example and precept thou didst teach us to ignore the body because it is perishable, and to attend to the concerns for the undying soul. Therefore, doth thy soul rejoice with the angels.
