THE TROPARION OF THE RESURRECTION in Tone 4

When the women disciples learned the joyful message of the Resurrection from the Angel, they cast away parental sin, and proudly told the message to the disciples, proclaiming that death hath been spoiled and Christ our God hath risen, granting to the world great mercy.

THE TROPARION of the FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT in Tone 2:

Before Thy Holy Icon bowed, we adore Thee Gracious Lord, and ask Thee to forgive our sins and our stumbling misdeeds, O Christ our God. For of Thine own free will when in the flesh thou wast pleased to mount the Cross to deliver us Thy creatures from enslavement to our foe. Wherefore we cry to Thee thankfully: Thou didst fill all things with gladness, O our Saviour; Thou didst fill all things with joy when Thou camest to save the world.

As Deliverer of captives, defender of the poor, healer of the infirm, champion of kings; victorious Great Martyr George, intercede with Christ our God for our souls' salvation.

To thee, our captain Queen of war, the battle trophies won, Thy people rescued by thine aid from peril, dedicate as our offering of thanksgiving O Theotokos, as thou hast might which none by war can overcome from all forms of danger hast thou delivered me, that I may cry unto thee, Hail, O Virgin unwedded bride.
